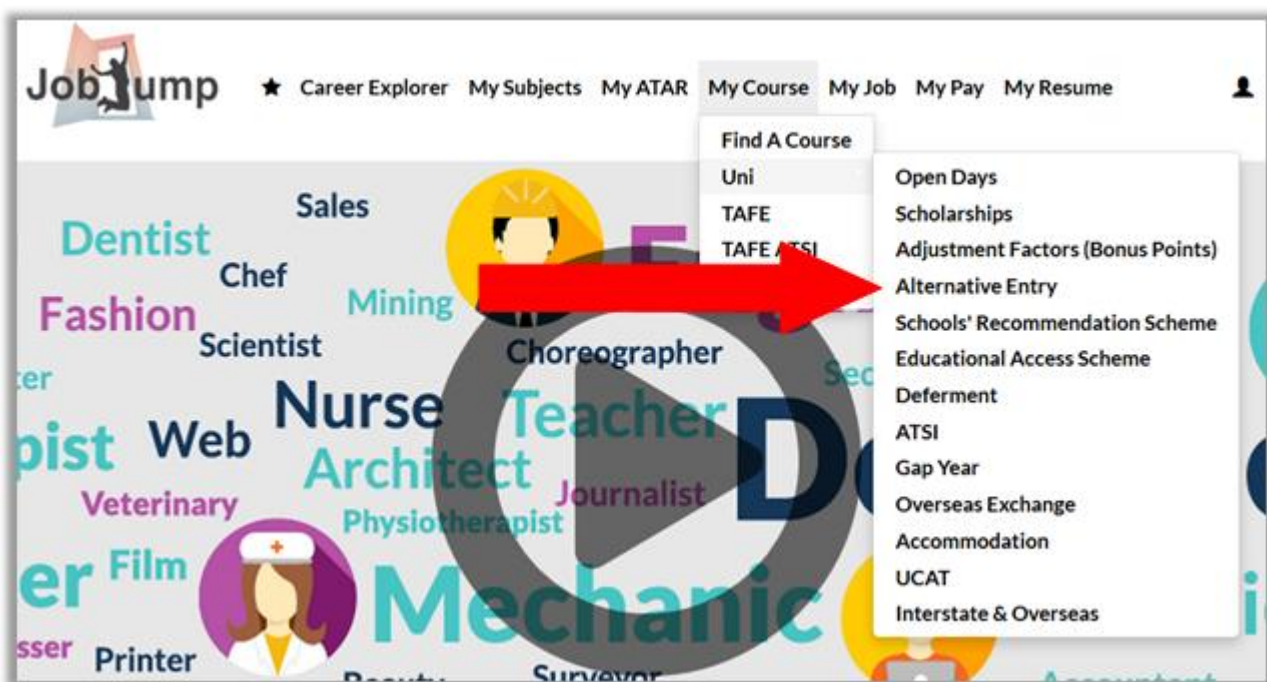


## Alternative Entry to University – Where there is a will there is a way

A young lady received an ATAR below 50. She wasn't ready yet for University study so she did a bit of work and when she was ready she did a University Preparation Course. The following year she began a Bachelor of Arts and did quite well in that first year. She was able to receive a transfer to their Law Degree. She did very well in her first year of studying Law. She approached UTS and sought a transfer to their Law Degree and was granted entry. The Law degree normally has an entry from the HSC of approximately 96! She completed her UTS Law degree with flying colours and is doing very well in her legal profession.

**Advice:**

Many universities will grant students acceptance who have come from other pathways. This can include such methods as:

- University Preparation or Foundation Courses
- Special Entry Schemes for the University
- Doing another degree you like and doing well in it
- TAFE Courses from Certificate 4 and higher
- Being mature age
- Demonstrated skill in particular fields related to your desired course
- Past work experience
- A combination of any of these options.

**Tip**

If you really want to head towards studying a particular degree, speak to their Course Information Advisors at an:

- Open Day
- Careers Expo
- Careers Adviser’s Interview
- Give them a call yourself.

**Ask them:**

- What methods can be considered for entry to the degree you like?
