- You can still attain your HSC.

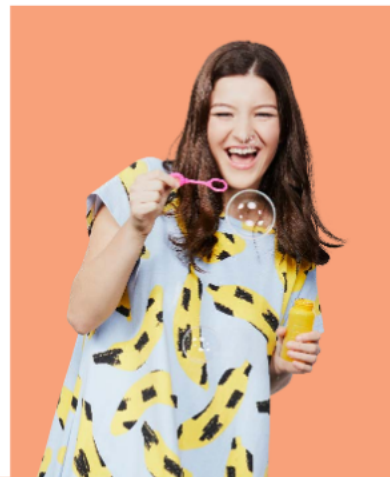
